NOTE: Early Voting is the BEST TIME to schedule your GOTV Event/s because ANY VOTER can VOTE at ANY POLL LOCATION!

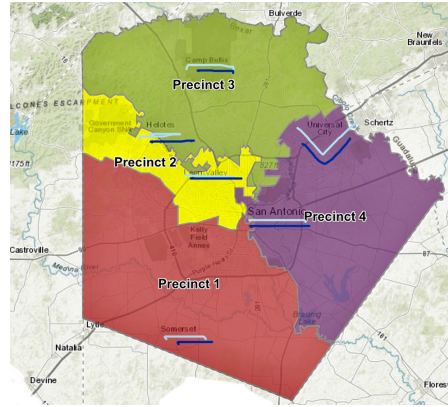

Be ready to contact people who have insight into ballot items and how they relate to your community's concerns.  
Invite someone who can look things up online.

### Plan an Election Watch Party

You can view coverage of Election results on a TV or online.  
You can listen to Elections coverage while knitting, coloring, sewing, cooking, studying, playing board games

### Schedule a Post Election Review

Discussion points: What was voter turnout? Who won? How will our communities be impacted by Election results?

### Power Map & Plan Next Steps Toward Accountability

What do we want? When do want it? How are we gonna get it?

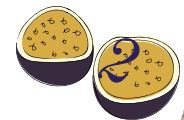
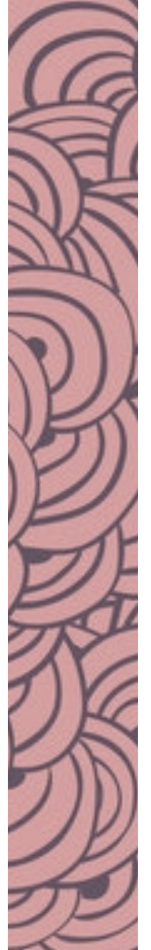
